## Wheel Course

This is a weekly course, with a 4-week or 8-week plan; each class is 3 hours. Depending on enrollment and group interests, the course outline is adaptable. This course focuses on learning to center the clay, building cylinders, bowls, plates, lidded vessels, pitchers, and tall forms, each of which requires a particular process. If you have done some wheel work previously and do not need a refresher in Week 1, you can work at your own pace from the beginning; for beginners there is a demonstration followed by hands-on practice to learn how to center the clay and 'pull' up a pot, whether it's a basic cylinder, bowl, plate, bottle, or vase. Subsequent classes will focus on trimming the bottoms of pots, adding handles, spouts, and lids, and then moving on to more complex forms and making multiples.

## Handbuilding

You have a 4-week or 8-week option to allow you to make as many projects as you wish. The course begins with pinch pots, and delves weekly into slab work, coiling, attaching elements such as handles, feet, and embellishments. You will explore adding texture using stamps, and decorating with underglazes and glazes. Your clay, glazes, and firing are included.

You will be able to make your own mug, plate, bowl, vase, garden markers, plaques, trays, and platters, just to name a few!

## Date Nights/Clay Buddies

You can book a private session for two people and enjoy an afternoon or evening of pottery, whether you want to make a pot by hand or learn to use the wheel. Come and try something new with a significant other. You will have a clay memento of your time in the studio!

## Team-Building Sessions

Team-building sessions provide an opportunity for you and your co-workers to enjoy creating pottery projects and bonding in a unique way. Use your imagination and open yourselves to new ideas while de-stressing for a few hours. See your co-workers in a new light and de-stress from the workday!

## Customized Workshops

Workshops can take place in the studio or in a location of your choice with groups ranging from 4 to 12 in the studio, or much larger groups in the setting of your choice. Groups can work on a specific pottery form as each participant brings individual flair to a particular project. Mugs, bowls, boxes, planters, plaques, and plates are among the options.
